17. Five Items around a: - ruby wedding anniversary

- 2) 1 Table Decoration (including flowers)
- 3) 1 Drink (may contain alcohol)
- 4) 1 Decorated Cake
(this to be a sample decoration of a small cake up to 20 cm diameter)
- 5) Item of Own Choice

All articles must be relevant to the theme. Items will be judged individually, although each group of five constitutes one entry. Maximum space allowed will be 2ft 6ins x 3 ft. A Merit Certificate will be given to the best item in this category and a shield for the highest mark overall.

CHILDREN'S SECTION

There are three age groups in this section, please write age of competitor on envelope attached to entry:

up to age 5 y.o.,

age 6 to 10 y.o. and

11 to 16 y.o.

18. Window box with Annuals (box not exceeding 1ft length)
19. lego model of any description use creativity.
20. Painting of household pet A4 paper
21. potato person e.g. Mr potato head the baker or carpenter etc.
22. animal made of dry food items (e.g. pasta, biscuits, icing sugar, sweets)
not exceeding the size of a dessert plate.

BONNIE GARDEN COMPETITION

23. Garden to be within a 2 mile radius of Old Rayne Market Cross
(secret judging)

RULES:

1. All exhibits must be the BONA FIDE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR
2. All exhibits must have competitor's name and address in a sealed envelope FIRMLY ATTACHED to the entry. The envelope should state the **category number** and in the case of children only, the age of the exhibitor.
3. All exhibits must arrive between 9.30 and 10.30 a.m. on the day of the show.
4. Exhibits in the miscellaneous and baking section must be placed on a white plate or bowl. Please refrain from using nuts or nut products in your produce.
5. Only ONE ENTRY PER PERSON PER CLASS will be allowed.
6. No article can be removed before 4.30 p.m., but must be removed by entrant by 5.30 p.m.
7. The judges' decisions are final.
8. Details of entries must be returned to one of the convenors by 15th August 2008 accompanied by the entrance fees which are listed below.
9. **Trophies** will be publicised in a local newspaper and **handed out at the Harvest Dance.**
10. The children's awards will be handed out on the day.

The sealed envelope with your name and address, which accompanies your entry, must be sealed and firmly attached to your entry with sellotape or with pins to handicraft products. Please write the class number on the outside of the envelope and age for children's entries.
